

little inferior to the original Demand upon Spain, and concluded a most gracious and honourable Peace with that Nation; leaving the grand Affair of the Search, and the Barbarities us'd towards her gallant Sailors, just where she found them. Thus ended this long, bloody, and taxing War; which was open'd with Bonfires at Home, carried on with Potguns in the Field, and ended with the loud Roar of Cannon in the Green Park, the 27th of April, 1749.

### ANNAPOLIS.

A few Days ago arrived in *Patuxent* River, from *London*, but last from *Gibraltar* and *Bermuda*, Capt. *Sejeant*, with the Proclamation of Peace, directed to his Excellency our Governor; and yesterday PEACE was proclaimed here.

Last Friday Morning died in *Carvert* County Col. *Gabriel Parker*, a worthy Inhabitant of that County; who was many Years Chief Justice and Deputy Commissary, and several Times High Sheriff of that County, which Place he held to the Time of his Death.

He is succeeded, as High Sheriff, by Mr. *John Skinner*; and as Deputy Commissary, by Mr. *Samuel Harrison*.

On Saturday last, DANIEL DULANY, Junr, Esq; Barrister at Law, was married to Miss REBECCA TASKER (second Daughter to the Hon. BENJAMIN TASKER, of this City, Esq;) a very agreeable young Lady, with a handsome Fortune.

We hear from *Philadelphia*, that the Ship *France* and *Elizabeth*, belonging to this Place, is arrived there from *Holland* with *Palatines*; many of whom died at sea: As did also Capt. *Anthony Beck*, late Commander of the said Ship.

This Day his Excellency the Governor, in Council, was pleased to prorogue the Assembly (which stood prorogued to the second Tuesday in *October*) to the second Tuesday in *February* next.
