 2. The Length under the Arm, down a few to the Waist.  
 3. The Length from the Top of the Breast, down to low as the lower Heels.  
 4. Take the Width quite round the Body, over the Breast.  
 5. Take the Width over the Breast, from Arm to Arm.  
 6. Take the Width round the Waist.  
 N. B. The above Directions, if carefully observed, will not only give the Measure as perfectly as any Stay-Maker.
