Bellec came from Lou burgh to Hallifax, and from thence to this town, a few months ago. He presends to be a protestant, and that he came here for the fake of religion; but we know of no article in our creeds, or confellions of faith, that teaches us to break open warehouses, and enrich ourselves with the spoil of our neighbours.

May 14. Last week three Frenchmen arrived here by land from Canada, with a packet from the governor there, to bis honour the commander in chief of this province; and by all we can yet discover, it appears that they are come on a very seveless errand; and 'tis generally thought, they have something of more importance in view.

Wednesday last capt. Ph hips fail'd for London, and 'tis fait cerried off about fixty thousand of the dollars lately released from their confinement in the treasury.

By the last letters from Hallilax we are informed, that by a ship arrived there from London they had advice, that a regiment of foldiers, and 600 English settlers, with 1500 Germans would be fent over this fummer, and that they would have a man of war and two sloops station'd there for their protection.

And from Annapolis Royal, that the French inhabiting those parts, had received orders from the governor of Canada, to leave their habitations, and come and fettle there, which some of them had done, and others were preparing to follow them. [A good riddance of bad neighbours.]
