Anaste is further Enasted, That the Money criting by fuch Sale, mall be by the respective sheriffs paid unto the Treaturers of the respective Shores of this Province, whose Receipt, for the fame, under Hanu and Seal, well Evidences, shall be a good Discharge to such Sheriff or Sheriffs; And the faid Treasurers thal, and they are hereby obliged and directed to, pay the sain Money from Time to Time, to the Visitors of

And whereas, by an Act entituled, A Petitionary All for Free Schools, made at a seffion of Assembly held at the Port of Innapolis, the first Day of July in the — Year of the Reign of King William the Third, of glorious Memory, in the Year of our Lord God, One Thouland Six Hundred Ninety and Nine, a school is appointed at Anne-Arundel Town, now the City of Annapolis, called King William's School, whereby Trustees were appointed, with a Power of succession, and incorporated into a Body Politic, capable of having, receiving, and holding Estates, to the uses of the said School, and perpetused by the Name of Redors, Governors and V fitors of King Wil. liam's School, reference to the same Act had, may appear, and inasmuch as the said School so established, hath some Foundation by the Git of the Honourable BENEDICT LEONARD CALVERT, Eiq; Deceased, and Others, though not sufficient to answer the End proposed. This General Assembly theretore, the better to establish and perpetuate the same, pray that it may be Enacted.

And be it nast d, That the faid King William's School in the City of Annapolis, shall be the School intended, construed, and meant to be by this Act est blished on the Weltern Shore of this Province, and that his Excellency Samuel Ogle, Esquire, the present Rector, Governors, and Visitors of the same School, and their Successors, shall, and are hereby Declared and Enacted to be the Rector, Governors and Visitors of the faid School, to the Ues, Purposes and Intents of this Act, and are hereby made capable to receive all Monies by this Act, given and granted for erecting and supporting one good School on the Western Shore of this Province, and that fuch Succession of Rector, Governors and Visitors, shall be perpetuated as is directed by the said last recited Act.

And for the better Establishment, and Concucting the said School at --- on the Eastern Shore of this Province,

Be it Enalled, That the Lands and Building now belonging to the County School of -- County, shall not be fold, but kept and preserved for the School intended by this Act; and that - - shall and are hereby Declared and Eracted to be Governors and Visit ore of the faid — School in — aforesaid, and that — shall for the Space and Term of Twelve Months next after the end of this Session of Assembly, be and is hereby declared, Rector of the same chool; and that from and after the Time afor faid, he the feid - -, and the Governors and Vifitors afore aid, or the major part of them, and their Succes-

fors, shall, and they are Declared and Enacted to be Incorporated into a Body Politic, by the Name of the Rector, Governors, and Visitors of - School in - , with full Power to plead and be impleaded, to sue and be sued, to defend and be defended, to answer and be answered, in all and every Cause, Complaint and Action, Real, Personal or Mixt, of whatsoever nature it shall be, in whatsoever Courts and Places of Judicature within the Kingdom of Great Britain, or the Dominions thereunto belonging, and have Power to receive a Grant, Gift, Affignment or Bequest, of any Lands, Tenements. or Hereditaments, Rents, Services, Annuities, Penfions, Inheritances, Franchifes and Possessions whatseever, Spiritual or Temporal, Goods or Chattels, to the yearly amount or value of One Thousand Pounds Sterling, to them the said — — and others the Governors and Visitors of the said --- School, or the major part of them, or Survivors of them Incorporate, and their Successors for Ever, to and for the Uses of the School aforefaid; and the faid - Governors and Visitors, and the longest Liver and Successors of them, be, and are hereby declared, the true, sole and undoubted Rector, Governors and Visitors of the faid - School in - - aforefaid, with full and absolute Power, Liberty and Authority, in making and ordaining fuch Laws, Orders and Rules, for the good Government of the faid -School, as to them the faid Rector, Governors and Visitor, or the major part of them, or their Successors, shall from Time to I ime, as occasion may require, seem meet, ne-cellary and becoming, all which shall be observed by the Mas-

the Penalties therein contained: Provided, That such Rules,

ters. Ulhers, and Scholars, of the faid-

Orders, and Laws, be no way contrary to the King Prerogal tive, the Rights of the Lord Proprietary, of this Province, or the Laws, Statutes, or Ulage of the Kingdom of Great. Bri. rain, or of this Province, or the Canons and Conflictions of the Church of England, as by Law established. And for the perpetuating the Succession of the said Rector, Governors, and Vintors.

Be it EnaAid, That after the Expiration of Twelve Months, to commence from the End of this Sellion of Affembly, or up. on the Death or Removal of him the faid - - , it shall and may be lawful for, and the said Rector and Visitors, or the major part of them, shall meet at - and there make choice of one discreet and fit Person from among themselves, to be Rector for the Year ensuing, or until another shall be chosen by them, the faid Governors and Visitors; and in case the said Rector, or any of the faid Visitors, shall die, or remove from this Province, whereby he is incapacitated to discharge the Duty thereof, that then, and in such case it shall be lawful for the residue of the said Visitors, with the Rector, if living, or within this Province, or the major part of them, to meet ataferefaid, and there to make choice of one other fit and difcreet Per on from among themse ves, to be Rector for the Year entung, or ustil another shall be chose and appoined in his Room, and so Yearly or as the case shall or may require, and to fill up the number of fuch Visitors as shall so be removed, or deceated, by the Vote of the remaining Rector, Governore, and Vilitors, or the mojor part of them, to as the number shall not exceed I wenty Governors and Vilitors, including the Rector, out of the principal and best of the Inhabitants residing on the Eastern hore of this Province.

And be it Enacied, by the Authority aforesaid, That the Rector fo as ato esaid appointed and choien, or which shall be hereafter choien, shail exercise the Power and Authority of Rector for one Year next after the faid Appointment, or such Choice, Death and legal Disability excepted, and longer, until fime other of the taid Governors and Visitors shall be chofen Rector of the faid chool.

And be it likewise Enacted, That the faidthey are nereby ordered and directed, to take the Oaths to the Government. Sign the same, and repeat and Sign the Tell, as also the following Oath, on the holy Evangelills of Almighty God, at their first Meeting at - aforetaid, before some Justice of the Peace of - County, viz.
