KNEMMER ELECTROVED.

William Kemmer who a year or two since brutally killed a witness at Berlin, New York, was electrocuted at the State Prison, on Wednesday morning, 6th inst., at 6.43 o'clock in the presence of twenty-three persons, whom the law permitted to be present.

Although the New York law provided that no extended account of the electrocution should be published in any newspaper in that State, nevertheless all the newspapers had very lengthy accounts, with outbursts to represent every phase of the horrible affair. The New York Herald seemed to excel all the newspapers in its graphic account. The coolest man in all the number present was Kemmer himself, who sat under Warden Durston in a wooden chair, which was bolted to the floor.

Warden Durston gave an agreed signal to a certain crowd, unknown to any one but himself, to press the electric button, which immediately caused the death of Kemmer, by immediate contact with the brain. The fatal current was left on Kemmer for 17 seconds, then taken off. The spasmodic action of the muscles of the body was mistaken by the doctors as signs of life, when they ordered the current turned on again, and so remained for 43 minutes.
