

five shillings six pence Sterling or the value thereof. And for the second
 offence five shillings Sterling or the value thereof. And for the third offence
 and for every time hee shall offend in like manner afterwards ten shillings
 Sterling or the value thereof and in case such offender or offenders shall not
 have sufficient goods and chattels within this Province to satisfy any of the
 aforesaid penalties respectively hereby imposed for prophaning the Sabbath
 or Lords day called Sunday as aforesaid then in every such case the party so
 offending shall for the first and second offence in that kind be imprisoned
 till he or shee shall publicly in open Court before the Sheriff, Comander, Judge
 or Magistrate of that County Town or precinct wherein such offence shall
 be committed acknowledge the Scandall and offence he hath in that respect
 given against God and the good and civil Government of this Province. And
 for the third offence and every time after shall also be publicly whipt
 and whereas the enforcing of the Conscience in matters of Religion hath
 frequently gone out to be of dangerous consequence in those Contries
 where it hath been practized. And for the more quiet & peaceable
 Government of this Province and the better to preserve mutuall love and
 unity amongst the inhabitants thereof. See it therefore also by the Lord
 Proprietary with the advice and assent of this Assembly ordered and enacted
 that as in this present act is before declared and set forth that no person
 or persons whatsoever within this Province or the Islands, Ports, Harbours
 creeks or rivers thereto belonging professing to believe in Jesus Christ shall
 from henceforth be in any way troubled, molested or discountenanced for or
 in respect of his or her Religion nor in the free Exercise thereof within
 this Province or the Islands thereto belonging nor any way compelled
 to the beliefs or Exercise of any other Religion against his or her Consent
 and as they be not unfaithfull to the Lord Proprietary or molest or
 conspire against the civil Government established or to be established in
 this Province under him or his heirs and that all and every person and
 persons that shall presume contrary to this act and the true intent
 and meaning thereof directly or indirectly either in person or estate
 willfully to disturb, wrong, trouble or molest any person whatsoever within
 this Province professing to believe in Jesus Christ for or in respect of his or
 her Religion or the free Exercise thereof within this Province otherwise than
 is provided for within this act, that such person or persons so
 shall be compelled to pay Triple Damages to the party so wrong
 molested. And for every such offence shall also forfeit and pay
 in money or the value thereof half thereof for the use of the Lord
 and Proprietary and Proprietary of this Province and
 the other half for the use of the party so wronged or molested as aforesaid.
