

Proprietary Neglecting also to take out grant from his Lordship under his great Seal of the Province for such lands as have been or are due unto such person or persons by virtue of his Lordships Conditions of plantation or other warrant from his Lordship which proceedings are not onely very great Contempts and prejudices to his Lordships dignity and rights but are also of such dangerous consequence if not timely prevented that they may hereafter bring a great confusion in the Governement and publick peace of this Province Be it therefore Enacted by the Lord Proprietary with the assent and approbation of the Upper & Lower house of this Assembly that all Purchases or Acquisitions whatsoever of any lands or Tenements within this Province which either already have been or which shall hereafter be made from any person or persons whatsoever not deriving at the same time a Lawfull title therunto by from or under some grant from time to time obtained or to be obtained - from his said Lordship or his heirs Lords and Proprietaries of this Province under his or their Great Seals of this Province for the time being shall be voyd and Null And it shall be Lawfull for the said Lord Proprietary and his heirs to enter upon & seize possess and dispose of any such lands or Tenements so from time to time purchased or acquired from any Indian or other as aforesaid at his or their will and pleasure unless such person or persons so purchasing or acquiring as aforesaid have some Lawfull right or title to the said lands or Tenements so purchased or acquired at the time of such purchase or acquisition by some grant under the great Seals of the Province from his said Lordship or his heirs Lords and Proprietaries of the same -

An Act of Oblivion

The Lord Proprietary is willing that it should be enacted And Be it enacted by the said Lord Proprietary with the Consent of the Upper and Lower House of this Assembly that there shall be an utter Abolition of all actions tending to Recover Damages for any faults committed against any one in his Lordships - Beare by any of the party who were in Rebellion against his Lordships Governmt. here at any time betwixen the fiftenth of February one thousand six hundred forty four and the fifth of August one thousand six hundred forty six Excepting Richard Ingle and John ~~Barber~~ Mariners and such others of the Isles of -
