Judges or their best discretion shall think fitt, And the Constable in every
shundred shall have one other sufficient able man along with him shall view every
mans Crops And for his paynes therein shall be allowed, and payd by every
respected offender against this present Act fifty pounds of Tobacco for every
acre that he shall fall short of that Proportion aforesaid respectively to be
divided equally betwixt the said Constable and the person so assisting him as
aforesaid —

An Act touching Indians

To the End that noe breach of peace may happen betwixt the Neighbouring
Indians And the Inhabitants of this Province. Bee itt Enacted by the Lord
Proprietary with the advice and Assent of the upper and lower house of this
Assembly that any one whosoever that shall take notice Surprize transport or
cause to be transported and Sell or dispose of any freind Indian or Indians —
whatsoduer or endeavour or attempt, soe to doe without License from the
Gouverneur for the tyme being, And all accessories therewnto shall suffer death
but not forfeite their or any of their Estates howbeit any one informing or
Causeing such offender or offenders to be Apprehended shall have such Satisfaction
for his paynes and diligence therein out of the said Offenders Estate and goods
as the Gouverneur and Councell shall thinke fitt. And itt is further Enacted by the
Authority aforesaid that noe Inhabitant of this Province shall deliver any
Gun or Gunns or Amunition or other kind of Martiall Armes to any Indian
borne of Indian Parentage for the selling of any meate or to any other use
without speciall License from the Lord Proprietary or the Gouverneur for the
tyme being upon payne of forfeiture to the Lord Proprietary one Thousand
pounds of Tobacco in Casks and Coffers of the partyes Gunn to him that shall
make Seizure thereof or take the same from such Indian or in forme and
make proof thereof. Andrew Ouramazinah being now Servant to Mr.
Henwick is hereby excepted from this Lawd —

An Acte for taking of an oath of fiddlity to the Lord Prop^{ty}

Bee it Enacted by the Lord Proprietary with the advice and consent of the
upper and lower house of this present Assembly that every person from time to time
inhabitting or Resyding within this Province. And such who have or shall from
tyme to tyme have any Estates and bee at any tyme in person within the same shall
take the oath hereunder mentioned in this act and intituled the Oath of fiddlity
to the Lord and Proprietary of this Province to be administered unto him and
them Respectively upon the holy Evangelists by the Lieutenant or Chiefe
Gouverneur of this Province —
