

Heires Lord and Proprietaries of this Province shall from tyme to tyme appoint
 paying a tenth in Weight or value for all the Beaver soe traded for for a
 Customs to his said Lordship and his heires Lord and Proprietaries of this
 Province Provided that noe person or persons who shall att any tyme hereafter
 trade as aforesaid doe Sell any Armes or Ammunition to any Indian or Indians nor
 impertinently maliciously or willfully quarrell with or give any Just Occasion
 of Offence to any Indian or Indians soe trading with him or them whereby
 the publick Peace or Safety of this Province may be Endangered by any warre or
 Insurrection of any of the said Indian or Indians or any mischief done by
 any of them to any of the Inhabitants or people of or in this Province. And
 Provided alsoe that noe person or persons who shall soe trade as aforesaid doe Enhance
 the Price of Corn att any tyme in any such trade to the Notorious Prejudice of
 the Inhabitants and people of and in this Province nor god forth upon any such
 trade too weake in Strength either in men or Armes and Ammunition whereby those
 Indians with whom they shall god to trade may be the more emboldened to
 destroy them or doe them mischief For the better prevention of all which It is alsoe
 enacted by the Authority and with the Assent aforesaid That all and every person or
 persons who shall desire to trade as aforesaid shall first from tyme to tyme have the
 Licence of the Lieutenant or Chief Governour of the province for the tyme being or
 of such officer or officers as hee or the Lord Proprietary or his heires shall from
 tyme to tyme appoint for soe trading who shall never deny such a Licence to an
 Inhabitant of this Province that shall att any tyme desire the same And that
 shall give such Security and Satisfaction as shall be reasonable and Just to the
 Lieutenant or Chief Governour or other officer or officers aforesaid that they and
 every of them respectively will observe and Comply with all and every of the Provisions
 abovesaid mentioned without which Licence Security and Satisfaction given as aforesaid
 noe person or persons whatsoever shall trade with any Indian or Indians either in
 or through any part of this Province any thing in this Act to the contrary ^{in any wise} not
 withstanding. And be itt further enacted that noe person or persons from tyme
 to tyme not being Inhabitants of this Province shall be permitted upon any
 Seames whatsoever to Trade with any Indian or Indians in or through any
 part of this Province without speciall Licence to be from tyme to tyme
 obtained for the same from the Lord and Proprietaries of this Province or his
 heires under his or their hand and Seale att Armes or his Lieutenant or Chief
 Governour of this Province for the tyme being un^{der} the great Seale of this
 Province upon payne of Confiscation to the Lord Prop^{rietaries} and his heires of all goods
 and Commodities Carried and attempted to be sold or which shall be purchased or
 acquired in or by any such trade or Comere or in case they cannot be seized in
 species then the value thereof when any such offence against this Act and the
 intent and meaning of this Clause thereof shall be discovered and when the
 person or persons soe offending or any of his ^{or} their monny goods or Chattels
 shall be apprehended or seized on in any part of this Province
