

Goods Chatter or land in their possession belonging to any who are under age shall exhibit an Inuentory and account of the said Estates within three months next after the publication of this Act to the Respective County Courts where such Estates shall be and afterwards yearly And in case such person or persons who haue such Estates in their hands doe not att the tymes and places aforesaid present the Inuentory and an account of such Estates as aforesaid then that the whole business be sent up to the Prouinciall Court And the offender to be att that Courts discrecon which Court upon Neglect of exhibiting as aforesaid or not good improvement made of the said Estates shall either suffer the said Estates to continue in the same persons Custody upon better Caution or Security or Remove the same into the hands of some able and discreet persons upon the Caution aforesaid Provided that no Child be putt into the hands of Overseers of a Contrary Judgment then that of their deceased Parents This Act to continue for three Yeares or to the End of the next Generall Assembly -

An Acte for Encouragement of such Souldiers as shall

Be itt Enacted by the Lord Proprietary by and with the consent of the upper and lower house of this present Generall Assembly That euery person that shall aduenture as a Soldier in any warre in defence of the Country and shall therein happen to be maymed or receiued hurt shall according to his place and quality Receiue Maintonance from the Country according to his disability for maintainding himselfe

An Acte for the appointment of Certain officers

Be itt Enacted by the Lord Proprietary of this Prouince by and with the consent of the upper and lower house of this present Assembly That the Justice of Peace in euery County att the first County Court hold after Michadlmas shall nominate and appoint some Inhabitants in euery hundred or Constablerij not being of the Councell or by his office or imployment otherwise priuiledged to be Constable of that Hundred or Constablerij who shall execute all precepts and warrants to him directed And shall in all things haue the like power within the said Hundred or Constablerij as any Constable hath or ought to haue in Constablerij in England by the Lawe or Customs of England The said
