An Acte for the Repeale of the Act for Customes
 This Assembly Considering the Clashing Betwenn the Law made att the Assembly held the second day of January one thousand six hundred forty six att Saint Inagoor Forts wherein in Consideration of the Customs in that Acte granted to his Lordship the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Proprietarij hee doth undertake the whole Charge of the Governement both in warre and in peace And that other Acte confirmed by his Lordships Declaration bearing date the sixth day of August one thousand six hundred and fifty Entituled An Act Concerning the Levying of Warre within this Province in the last clause of which Act the whole Charge of any warre arising within this Province is to be levied upon the province by an Equall Assentment upon the persons and Estates of the Inhabitants thereof any thing in that Acte or any other Act to the Contrary thereof notwithstanding And further taking into serious Consideration the burden of that Acte and the vast Charge that hath been drawn upon the Province by the late treacherous Revolts of Josias Fendall and his Complices And the great Expences they must be att to defend the Province against the Inursions of the Sandoa Indians that of late have murdered some of the Inhabitants thereof the which Charge by Act of this present Assembly they have undertaken Doe pray that by authority of the Lord Proprietarij with the Assent of the upper and lower house of this Generall Assembly the said Acte made att an Assembly held the second day of January one thousand six hundred forty six att Saint Inagoor Forts and Entituled an act for Customs may be Repealed And Bee itt Enacted by the Authority and Consent aforesaid that the said Act for Customs is hereby utterly Repealed for ever

An Act for port duties and matters of ships —
 Bee itt Enacted by the Lord Proprietarij with the Assent of the upper and lower house of this present Generall Assembly that whatsoever not properly belonging to this Province but which is used in the course of trade and trafficking within this Province shall pay for every Tunn of goods or commodities whatsoever not properly used as aforesaid in the course of trade or Anchorage for so much in value for
