And likewise doth engage her selfe sufficiently to leave the dwelling
house without further Consideracon or allowance over and aboue the
afforsaid sume of two hundred thousand pounds of Tobacco this present year
And also to dwell and keepe ordinary in the same for the term of
three years for the Necessarie and requisite accomodation of all —
Bee it therefore Enacted by the Authority of this present Generall Assembly
That the said Hannah Lee shall make ouer unto and Just Comedyne
of the said land and houesing att Saint Marys where she now dwells —
and other Appurtenances belonging therunto att the next Provinciale
Court to be held in Bund next to the Gouernour and Councell And to be kept
in the Secretarys office of this Province And Bee it further Enacted —
by the Authority aforesaid That the said sume of Two hundred Thousand pounds
of Cylled Tobacco bee payed to the said Hannah Lee for her said house and
Plantacon and bee payed by an Equall Assessment upon every
taxable person Inhabiting or Resyding within this Province —
