

Any Trayning Mustring daye for military Concernment or Election of Burgesses Provided always that itt shall and may be Lawfull for the Sheriffe or any other officer to apprehend and Carry to prison any person or persons for Ryotts felony or Suspicion of Felony or for Escapes out of Prison when under Execution upon any day att any place any thing in this Act to the Contrary — Notwithstanding Provided also that it may be Lawfull for any Sheriffe to Arrest any person or persons att a Mustring day that is not bound to attend the Mustre there to receive and Trayne And this Act to Continue for three yeares or to the End of the next Generall Assembly —

An Acte for Amerciaments in the Provinciaall & County Courts Whereas many Sutes are Rayed upon frivolous occasions by litigious persons for prevention thereof for the future Bee itt Enacted by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary by and with the Consent of the upper and lower house of this present Generall Assembly that all persons whatsoever that are Cast in any cause be they Plaintiff or Defendant shall be amerced (besides the damages and Cost to the Recoverour) fifty pounds of Tobacco in the Provinciaall Court to be imployed as the Governour and Council shall thinke. And in the County Courts thirty pounds of Tobacco to be Imployed as the Commissioners shall thinke fitt For the due Collecting whereof Bee itt Enacted by the Authority aforesaid that the Clarke of the Provinciaall Courts and the severall County Courts keep an Exact Account of the Amerciaments and deliver or send the same to the severall Sheriffes of the particular Counties who are hereby required to collect the same with the Levys and accordingly Impowred for default of Payment to make distresses and Comanded not to Returne any Arraunders Executors & Administrators who cannot pay without orders always Excepted) And be itt further Enacted That the Clarke of the Respective Courts shall give unto the Chief Judge of every Court a list of the Amerciaments that Court Imposed this Act to Continue for three yeares or to the next Generall Assembly —

An Act for the Repoale of an act made Anno 1661 Entituled an Act concerning killing wild Cattle —

Whereas sundry Inhabitants of this Province finding themselves much aggrieved being Restrayned by vertue of that Act made att St. Johns the seventeenth of April one thousand six hundred sixty one by Phillip Calvert Esq. intituled an Act concerning killing wild Cattle whereby all persons having any marked Cattle amongst wild Gangs cannot profume to kill their owne marked Cattle att any tyme of the yeare for their owne Conventiencie Doe therefore pray that it may be Enacted And Bee itt Enacted by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary by and with the Consent of the upper and lower house of this present Generall Assembly That that Act concerning killing wild Cattle be and is hereby utterly Repealed for ever —
