An Act Limiting the Extent of Attachments
and Providing what shall be Levied upon
such Attachments & Executions

We the Delegates of the Lower house of this present Generall Assembly having taken
into our serious Consideration the many mischiefs and inconveniences accruing to the
good people of this your Lordships Province and other Merchants trading in and
therewto by Reason of Attachments issued out of the Provinciall & County Courts of
this Province grounded upon an act of Assembly held at Saint Johns the fourth day of
March one thousand six hundred forty Seven Intituled an act touching the Extent
of Attachments and Executions whereby amongst other things it is Enacted that no
Attachment shall or may be laid upon any the goods and Chattels of any Inhabitant
within this Province Except the true owner thereof be not at that time Resident or
dwelling within this Province by Colour of the Authority of which Act thered being
no certain Rule prescribed for proceeding upon such Attachments the Estates of
the several people of this Province have in their absence out of the Province been
Condemned and Seized without the parties Privity or making any defense by
himselfe or his Attorney and the said party or parties so absent are by the practice
of the said several Courts Excluded and Disbarred from making any Just defense
against the said Attachments though Issued out upon very slender proof and
Security unless he or they by him or them selves or his or their attorney come
within aye and aday after the said Attachment Issued out and make such
their defense to the great prejudice and almost utter Ruine of many of the
good people of this Province and Merchants trading therin and therunto

We do humbly pray that it may be Enacted And Bee it Enacted by the
Right Honble the Lord Proprietary of this province by and with the advice and
assent of the upper and lower house of this present Generall Assembly ordain'd and
Enacted That from and after the Publication hereof all and every person and
persons whatsoever Inhabitants within this Province and all and sundry the
Merchants trading hither and leauing Effects here that shall depart this Province
that all and every such person Inhabitant and Merchant that shall so depart
this Province shall before their departure make Constitute and ordaine one or
more Attorney or Attorneys for them in all actions writt or plaints whatsoever to
be brought ~~against~~ against them by any other person or persons whatsoever in
any Court or Courts whatsoever And the said Letter of Attorney to Adcord in the
Provinciall Court and in the County Courts where they did last Remayne and
Inhabit Bedford he or they shall be admitted to have any passe to Sycamore
such his or their departure and that no Attachment shall be laid upon
any the goods or Chattels of any Inhabitant within this Province Except he or
