 of twelve men of his County to Enquire what damages itt wold be to the
 Lord Proprietary or others to haue amill Sett up in such place as aforesaid
 the forme of which writt followeth vizt.

 greeting and command you that by the Oathes of twelve honest and lawfull men
 of the County by custome the truth of the matter may be better knowne
 diligently to inquire if itt be to the Damages of us or others if we grant —
 to N. N. of N. County 1000 Acres of Land lying att N. in the County aforesaid
 on each side of the Runn of water thereto Running together with liberty and
 licence theron to sett a certaine watermill as also liberty to take, sell,
 Cut downe and carry away either by land or water any wood or timber
 fitt for building of amill other then timber fitt to spilit into Lapboards vpon
 any the lands next adjoyning to the said 1000 Acres of Land lying on such side
 the Runn of water att N. N. aforesaid in the County aforesaid And if itt be to
 the damage or prejudice of us or others then to what damage and what prejudice
 of vs and to what damage and prejudice of others and of whom and in what
 manner and how and of who or of whom the aforesaid 1000 Acres of Land
 are helden and by what service and in what manner and how and of what
 value they are by the year according to the true value of them now before any
 further improvement made of the said 1000 Acres and who and the present
 possessors of the said 1000 Acres and who and how many and the measures between
 us and the present possessors of the said 1000 Acres and what lands or demesnes —
 remain to the present possessors over the said 1000 Acres And if the lands —
 remaining to the present possessors over the said 1000 Acres will suffice to —
 uphold their manor vizt the sixth part of the Maner allotted by the —
 conditions of plantation for the Demasnes as before the alienacion for building
 of amill And that the said possessors in affidavt Juryes and recognicsons may
 be putt as before the alienacion so that the County by the alienacion aforesaid
 in default of the present possessors more then was wont be not charged and —
 grieved and the Inquisition thereupon openly and distinctly made to us in our
 Chancery under thy Seal and the Seals of them by whom itt was made —
 without delay and & upon Returns of which writt in case the person
 or persons whereby the said Inquist shall be found to be the true owners and
 possessors of the said land fitt to build a mill vpon shall profuse to build —
 amill thereon and to give security to the Lord Proprietary by bonds of fifty
 thousand pounds of tobacco with condition to begin to build amill theron —
 within
