

Within twelve moneths from that day to be computed and reckoned and the same
 building to prosecute and finish within twelve moneths after the beginning or laying the
 foundation as aforesaid for the publick good of the Province it shall be Lawfull to and
 for his said Lordship his heires or Successors or in his or their abſence for his or their
 Lieutenant or Chiefe Gouernour here for the tyme being from time to time to grant
 any such tyme Acre or land fit to buil a water mill vpon as aforesaid together
 with free egraffe and Regrafte to the faid watermill either by land through any man
 land next adjacent or deo by water together with liberty to fell any Timber for
 building the said water mill other then board Timber fit to ſprall or cleave into
 clapboards for any time or forme not exceeding Eighty yeards then next to come
 vnder the yearly Rent of the land then by the Oathes of twelve men by virtue
 of the writt aforesaid returned to be payd to the owner of the land ſo found and
 returned as aforesaid which ſaid grant from his ſaid Lordship his heires and Successors
 or from his Lieutenant and Chiefe Gouernour here as aforesaid ſhall be good and
 waylable in law to the grantee as aforesaid for any forme of yeards not exceeding
 Eighty yeards as aforesaid againt all persons whatsoeuer any law custome or vſage heret
 before had made or vſed within this Province to the contrary hereof notwithstanding
 PROVIDED alwayes that before any person or persons whatſoever ſhall have ſuch
 grant to buil a water mill as aforesaid they ſhall enter into a bond to the Lord
 Proprietary with two ſufficient Sureties in the ſumme of fifty thouſand pounds
 of Tobacco with conditions to begin to buil the faid water mill within twelve
 moneths then next to come after ſuch bond given and the ſame building to
 prosecute and finish within twelve moneths after ſuch beginning
 And for the great advantage that is already found to the province in generall by
 the mills alreadie buil some of which do stand vpon lands wherof the title is
 doubtfull for want of due forme of the Conveyances or the last wills and Testaments
 by which the lands haue been conveyyed or devized to the builders of ſuch mills bee
 it further enacted By the Authority advice and consent aforesaid that all and every
 ſuch person or persons who haue buil mills hall or may haue ſuch writt or writts
 as aforesaid to Enquier of the true yearly value of the land wheron ſuch mill doth
 stand and of Tolls and other charges on each ſide the River as aforesaid and upon Returns of
 ſuch writt as aforesaid in forme aforesaid ſhall haue a grant from his Lordship
 or his heires or his or their Lieutenant here as aforesaid for any forme not exceeding
 Eighty yeards and under the yearly Rent returned as aforesaid to be payd to the
 right owner of the land as aforesaid any law vſage or custome within this Province
 haue made or vſed to the contrary hereof notwithstanding —
