

wooden measures And three other Stamps for the powder measures to be all of the same  
 Letter with their other Stamps And that the said weights measures and Stamps be kept  
 by the Respective persons aforesaid at their aforesaid houses whether all persons  
 are to bring their Stillyards to be tryed Stamped and Numbered ones a yard also their  
 Barrels which are to containe fire Bushells and other measures to be sealed  
 And all persons selling by other weights or measures which are not tryed Stamped -  
 Numbered and Sealed as aforesaid shall forfeite one thousand pounds of Tobacco for -  
 every default the one halfe to the Lord Proprietary the other halfe to the Informer  
 to be Recovered in any Court of Record within this Province And it is further -  
 Enacted by the Authority aforesaid that no Stillyard that carries gross weight shall  
 be admitted or stamp'd at any Standard within this Province And in Consideration  
 of the trouble paine and charge which the person aforesaid must use and bee at  
 in performing this office It is hereby further enacted by the Authority aforesaid  
 that at every person or persons for every time that any persons shall have their Stillyard  
 and for a tryed Stamped and Numbered shall pay unto such person that shall have the  
 keeping of the said Standard the sume of two Shillings and six pence for -  
 every wooden and powder measure markt and if any person without just cause  
 shall trouble another to try his Stillyard after stamp'd and Numbered by this -  
 Standard such person shall pay and satisfy the fee to the officer so due as -  
 aforesaid And it is hereby further enacted by the Authority aforesaid that one  
 thousand six hundred pounds of Tobacco be this present year leav'd in every  
 several and Proprietary County within this province to be paid this Prop'r now  
 ensuing unto each Respective person aforesaid for the Purchasing of the  
 aforesaid Weights measures and other the materials And in case the same is not  
 sufficient to purchase the same after a Just account delivered into the Commissioner  
 of each Proprietary County of the first penny in England with all other disbursements  
 which will accrue thereby allowing one penny for every pound of Tobacco Then the said  
 Commissioner hereby are enjoyned to Tax so much as shall be wanting thereof in the  
 ensuing County leavy And if in case the said sume of Sixteen hundred pounds  
 of Tobacco will overpay their said disbursements at one penny per pound Then such  
 person or persons are to be accountable for the overplus the Prop'r that shall Enforce  
 the Arrivall of the said goods to the County that shall disburse the same And if in case  
 any of the persons aforesaid shall make default of procuring and purchasing such  
 weights measures scales Stamps and Numbers as by this Act they are enjoyned by the  
 time before limited the said person or persons shall be fined three thousand pounds of  
 one halfe therof to the Lord Proprietary and the other halfe to the County where such  
 default shall be made and where the same shall be Recovered by Bill plaint or
