

wooden measures And three other Stamps for the powder measures to be all of the same
 Letter with their other Stamps And that the said weights measures and Stamps be kept
 by the respective persons aforesaid at their aforesaid houses whether all persons
 are to bring their Stillyards to be tryed Stampd and Numberd ones aynd also their
 Barrells which are to contayne five Bushells and other measures to be sealed
 And all persons selling by other weights or measures which are not tryed Stampd
 Numberd and Sealed as aforesaid shall forfeite one thousand pounds of Tobacco for
 every default the one halfe to the Lord Proprietary the other halfe to the Informer
 to be Recovered in any Court of Record within this Province And it is further
 Enacted by the Authority aforesaid that no Stillyards that Carrys gross weight shall
 be admitted or Stampd att any Standard within this Province And in Consideration
 of the trouble paines and Charge which the person aforesaid must use and be in
 in performing this office It is hereby further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid
 that every person or persons for every time that any persons shall have their Stillyard
 and scale tryed Stampd and Numberd shall pay unto such person that shall have the
 keeping of the said Standard the Sum of two Shillings and also Six pence for
 every wooden and powder measures markt and if any person without Just Cause
 shall trouble another to try his Stillyards after Stampd and Numberd by the
 Standard such person shall pay and satisfy the fee to the officer soe due as
 aforesaid And it is hereby further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid that one
 thousand six hundred pounds of Tobacco be this present years Levied in every
 severall and Respective Counties within this province to be paid this Crosse now
 ensuing unto each Respective person aforesaid for the Purchasing of the
 aforesaid Waights measures and other the materials And in case the same is not
 sufficient to purchase the same after a Just account delivered into the Commissioners
 of each Respective County of the first penny in England with all other disbursements
 which will accrue thereby allowing one penny for every pound of Tobacco Then the said
 Commissioners hereby are Enjoyned to Tax soe much as shall be wanting thereof in the
 ensuing County Levie And if in case the said Sum of six hundred pounds
 of Tobacco will overpay their said disbursements att one penny per pound Then such
 person or persons are to be accountable for the overplus the Crosse that shall ensue
 the Arrivall of the said goods to the County that shall disburse the same And if in case
 any of the persons aforesaid shall make default of procuring and purchasing such
 weights measures Scales Stamps and Numbers as by this Act they are Enjoyned by the
 time before Limited the said person or persons shall be fined three thousand pounds of
 one halfe thereof to the Lord Proprietary and the other halfe to the County where such
 default shall be made and where the same shall be Recovered by Bill plaint or
 Information
