

Cause of Record within this Province —

Provided always That one half of the money by this Act to be Raised be Employed towards the maintaining a Constant Magazine with Arms and Ammunition for the defence of this Province and defraying other Publick Necessary Charges of the Government

Provided always that so long as this Act shall continue no publick Levy shall be laid upon the freemen & inhabitants of this Province but by Consent of the said freemen in open assembly first had and obtained And that during the continuance of this Act as aforesaid the last Clause of an Act Intituled an act concerning Levying war within this Province by which Cause it is Enacted that all Charges arising from time to time by defence of this Province against any Invasion of any Enemy or Enemies or against any domestick Insurrections or Robberies against the Publick peace of this Province or the Government Established herein and under the Lord Proprietary and his heirs Lord and Proprietary of this Province shall be defrayed by the Province by an Equall Assessment upon the persons and Estates of the Inhabitants thereof shall be and Remayne suspended any thing in that Act to the contrary notwithstanding The foregoing Clauses in the said Act Remaying still in full force and vertue

Provided also that so long as this Act shall continue his said Lordship his Receiver or Receivers Generall for the time being shall Receive good Sound and Merchantable Tobacco when vendred for his said Lordships Rent or rents for Alienation of lands Reserved upon the severall and Respective grants of land in this Province at the Rate of two pences per pound any thing in his said Lordships grants to the contrary hereof notwithstanding. Provided also and it is hereby Enacted by the Right Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Lord Proprietary by and with the Consent of the upper and lower houses of this present Generall Assembly that the Act Entituled an act for the muster master Generall shd be & for ever hereforward stand Repealed

This Act to continue during the Naturall life of the Right Hon<sup>ble</sup> Cecilus now Lord & Proprietary of this Province and for one yeare more next after his decease & no longer —
