

Hereofor made for the Limitting and Staying of Lawes &c who are hereby  
Repealed this Act to Continue and Remains in force for the Space of three years  
or to the end of the next Session of Assembly which shall first happen —

An Act for the killing of wolves —

Bee it Enacted by the Right Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Lord Proprietary by and with the  
advice and Consent of this present Generall Assembly That every person who  
Shall bring the head of a wolf to any of the Commissioners or Justices of the peace in  
any County of this Province shall be allowed two hundred pounds of Tobacco  
from the County where the wolf shall be killed and that such Commissioner or  
Justice of the peace to whom the wolfs Head shall be brought shall Cut or  
cause to be Cutt out the Tongue and cut or cause to be Cut of the ears of the said  
wolfs Head to prevent the receipt of twice or after paying for the same this  
Act to continue for three years or to the end of the next Sessions of Assembly which  
shall first happen —

And Bee it further Enacted that all other acts formerly made for the  
killing of wolves &c and are hereby Repealed

An Act for the preservation of Orphans Estates

Forasmuch as the former laws made in this Province concerning Orphans  
Estates are found by experience to be very defective & not wiser sufficient  
for the preservation of Orphans Estates according to the Ends and purposes  
therby Intended and desired the Delegates in this present assembly now  
assembled pray that it may be enacted And Bee it Enacted by the Right  
Honourable the Lord Proprietary of this Province with the advice and Consent  
of the upper and lower house of this present Generall Assembly and the  
Authority of the same That all last wills and Testaments shall be made  
Inviolable unless the Executor or Overseers thereby appointed doth Refuse  
to Execute the trust in them Required by the Testator in which case the Chief  
Judge for probate of wills and granting administration shall grant  
Administration with the will annexed to some other person as in his  
discretion shall seeme meete But if the will be soe made that no person  
will undertake the management of the said Estate and Education of the  
Orphans according to the intention of the said will then the Estate by the  
appointment of the Justices of the County Court where the Estate shall ly and bee  
shall be managed according to those following Rules hereafter in this present Act  
prescribed alwaies provided the children if any be committed to persons of the same  
Religion of their deceased parents And it is further Enacted by this present Generall  
Assembly and the Authority of the same That when any person whatsoever
