

First that no Negroes or other Slaves shall be sold or disposed of by any Administrator for payment of debts or otherwise or Reserved for the Administrator's use in satisfaction for any debt due to the said Administrator nor any Execution served upon any Negroes or other Slaves so long as there shall be other goods of the deceased sufficient to satisfy the Just debts of the deceased that no account be allowed for dyett (Clothes Physick or Education against any Orphan's Estate but that they be provided for and Educated by the Interest of their Estate and Increase of their Stock according to the proportion of their Estates if it will beare it but if the Estate be so meane & inconsiderable that it will not extend to a free Education That it is Enacted that such Orphan's shall be bound apprentices to some handycraft Trades or other person at the discretion of the Justice of the County Court untill and twenty yeares of age Except some kinsman or Relation will maintaine them for the Interest of their small Estate they have without diminution of the Principall which whether great or small shall allwaies be delivered at the yeares by this Act appointed —

3<sup>thly</sup> That all Cattle Horses Sheepe be Returned in kinde by the Guardians according to the age and Number when as he Receiveth them and because severall kind be for the making of this Act Estates of Orphan's in their hands which they kept for the male Increase and giving a yearly account of the Augmentation or Diminution of the Orphan's Stocks which by Carelessness or wickedness of the Guardians was usually consumed before they came to age and disputes thereupon arising in the severall Courts how such portions should be proceeded with and account of the Orphan's Estates how to be given them It is hereby declared that all persons possessed of Orphan's Stocks before the making of this Act shall be bound to deliver to the Orphan's when he comes of age such and so many of any kind as he is possessed with when he gives his account to the next Orphan's Court succeeding the Publication of this Act —

4<sup>thly</sup> That all plate monie Rings & Jewells be preserved & delivered in kind according to the weight and quantity and that other household stuffe & Lumber be appraised in monie and the value thereof paid by the Guardian to the Orphan when he comes to age either in monie Sterling according to appraisment or in Tobacco at the then price current and in case any difference shall arise what shall be the then price current that the Judges of the County Court where the Orphan's Estate doth lye determine what shall be the then price current —

5<sup>thly</sup> That every male Orphan shall be account to be of full age at the yeares of one and twenty and at that age to Receive his Estate from the Guardian but in case any person by his last will and Testament doe appoint any person
