 Generall or Speciall or Remainder upon any Estate taylor or come to them by any discent
 in fee simple or fee taylor Generall or Speciall or Remainder upon any Estate taylor
 as aforesaid or by any other Lawfull Conveyance or Conveyances or means whatsoever
 as if they had all been borne within this Province or were of Brittish or Irish discent
 as aforesaid And also that they and every of them from hence forth may and shall be
 Enabled to prosecute maintain & avow Justified & defend all manner of actions Suits plaints
 and other demands whatsoever as Liberally frankly freely fully Lawfully & securely
 as if they and every of them had been Naturall borne within this Province of Maryland
 or were of Brittish or Irish discent or as any other person or persons Naturall borne
 within this Province or of Brittish or Irish discent may any way Lawfully doe any
 Law Priviledge Act or Customs of this Province or other thing whatsoever had made
 ordeined or done within this Province to the Contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding

An Act of gratitude to his Excellency Charles Calvert Esq^r
 Cap^l Generall of Maryland

Whereas by an Act made at a Generall Assembly hold at the City of St Maries the xxvijth
 day of March in the xxxvijth year of your Lordships Dominion over this Province Anno
 Domini 1671 Intituled an act for the Raising & Providing of a support for his Lordship
 the Lord and Proprietary of this Province during his naturall life and likewise a supply
 towards the defraying the Publick Charges of Government itt was enacted that from & after
 the first day of September then next Coming there should be Rayed Levied Collected and
 payd unto your Lordship your heirs & Successors Lord & Proprietary of this Province
 the sume of two shillings Starling for every hogshoad & quantity of an hogshoad of
 Tobacco which should be at any tyme then after shipped in any shipp or vessell to be
 Exported out of this Province or any the Territories Islands ports Rivers Creeks or
 places therunto Belonging And itt was also thereby Enacted that the
