

And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid that the Surveyor General or his Deputy shall keep a book of all the Surveys that he or they shall make together with fair Blotts of the same And the said Books kept by the Deputy Proportionately shall be yearly Returned to the Surveyor General and in case the Surveyor General or his Deputy or Deputyes shall neglect to keep such books as aforesaid whereby any person within this Province shall suffer damage by the losse of his Land Surveyed or otherwise -

Bee it further Enacted that the said Surveyor General his Deputy or Deputyes in whom the fault shall be found to be shall be liable to satisfie all such damages as shall be adjudged against him in the Provinciall Court in which Court only the said damage shall be tried and for the avoyding of all contests between the Surveyors and the people of this Province -

Bee it Enacted by the Authority aforesaid that the Surveyor General or his Deputy or Deputyes Proportionately shall before he or they demand his fees be bound to deliver a certificate of his Survey to the party for whom he surveyed the Land and that the said party deliver the same into the office according to his warrant this Act to Repeale all other Laws concerning Surveyors fees and to continue for three years or to the end of the next Generall Assembly which shall first happen -

An Act for the payment of fees due from
Criminall persons

Whereas divers Complaints have been made by severall Creditors of this Province occasioned for that they have been forced to pay the fees of Impresoneed Criminally the persons by whom such fees ought heretofore to have been paid or here after to be paid being released and going free to the great Encouragement of offenders for prudencie whereof for the future

Bee it Enacted by the Right Honble the Lord Proprietarie by and with the aduise and consent of the upper & lower houses of this present Generall Assembly and the Authority of this same that from hence forward no person either Sheriff or Gaoler shall charge either their own County to which they doo belong or the Publike with any fees for any Criminall committed to him or their Charge having a sufficient Estate in this Province whereupon to pay the same or being Capable to make satisfaction for the same by servitude or otherwise but that such Criminall as aforesaid being discharged by order of Court of Law shall pay his own fee to the Sheriff or Gaoler
