any person or persons within this Province shall wilfully and maliciously burn
and destroy any Corn field Pasture ground orchard or other fence or fences —
whereby any of the Inhabitants of this Province are harassed and damaged the
person so offending being thereof convicted by the Testimony of two sufficient
witnesses shall suffer such penalties or undergo such punishment as the Lawes
of England providers against such malicious persons and Practices of that nature
or make restitucon to the person wronged by paying trouble the damage
sustained thereby at the Justices before whom such case shall come shall determine
this Act to endure for three years or to the end of the next Generall Assembly —
which shall first happen —

An Act concerning taxable persons

Whereas divers Servants and dayly Imported into this Province and many disputes
arising concerning their ages and when they are to be accounted Taxable Bee it Enacted
by the Right Honble the Lord Proprietary by and with the Consent of the upper and
lower houses of this present Generall Assembly that all male Children borne in this
Province and Resident in it shall be accounted Taxable att the age of Sixteene years
and upward and all male Servants Imported into this Province att the age of ten years
and upward shall be accounted Taxable and all Slaves whatsoever whether male or
female Imported or borne in the Province att or above the age of ten years shall
be likewise accounted Taxable and soe Rated accordingly and that all free men
Resident in this Province except ministers & priests shall be Taxable being above
the age of Sixteene years this act to endure for three years or to the end of the next
Generall Assembly which shall first happen —

An Act declaring what shall be done by the Sheriff ex officio

Whereas certain charges are lately aiseen in this Province by the Sheriff exacting fees
for several matters and Executing several writs and precepta and for summoning of
Juryors in Criminal cases and other matters only Relating to the Publick which formerly
were done & Executed and still ought to be done ex officio —

Bee it therefore enacted by the Right Honble the Lord Proprietary by and with
the advice and consent of the upper & lower houses of this present Generall Assembly
and the Authority of the same that from henceforth no Sheriff within this Province
shall take Exact or Recived of or from any person whatsoeuer any fees Salary
gratuity or reward for the Serving or Executing any writ warrant or precept from
the Gouernour or Council or from any Justice of the Peace within this Province or
for the doing of any other thing in any the Courts of Record in this Province for
any matter or thing or upon any Suit or Suits in Criminal cases but such Sheriff
