The Second of July 1699 whereby you did impower your Governor from time to time to grant lands unto any person or persons of French Dutch Spanish Swedish or other foreigne dissent in the same and in as ample manner and upon the same terms and Provisions as he was therby impowered to grant lands to any person or persons of Brittish or Irish dissent and dowering their said abode thereupon have beene alwaies faithfull & obedient to your Lordships Lawes yoll for that your Subjects and not of Brittish or Irish dissent they cannot take benefit of the Lawes and Customs of this Province as other thd. Said people of this Province of Brittish or Irish dissent may to their great losse hindrance & prejudice as also to the deterring of others of the same foreigne nations afforsed from coming into this Province and by consequence forslowing the populating of this Province with usefull artificers and handicraftsmen May it therefore yllowse your Lordships of your abundant goodness and conterne care of and over this Province that it may be enacted & ordered by your Lordship And Be it ordained & enacted by the Right Hon^eble the Lord Prop^r of this Province by and with the advice & consent of the upper & lower houses of this present Generall Assembly that your Lordships humble Subtitioners John Brown, William Dick, Cornelius Johnson, Axell Stille, Henry Freeman, Marcus Tyerson, Jeffry Jacobson, Henry Henderson, Oliver Colle, Mount Anderson, Lawrence Christian, James Peterson, Cornelius Eckerson, John Desjardins, Martin Mugenbrough, Henry Matthews, Henry Innes, John Hender, Andrew Clements, Bridget Aranson, Lester Corder, John Lacount, Mord Lequent, Phillip Lequent, Anthony Lacount, Lester Lequent, Katherine Lacount, they and every of them shall from hence forth be adjudged & taken as naturall born people of this Province of Maryland and alfor that they and every of them shall and may from hence forth by this same Authority be enabled and adjudged to all intents and purposes able to demand challenge as he have hold and enjoy any land, tenement, rents & Worrdamants within this Province as their or Heires to any of their Ancestors by reason of any dissent in ffor single ffor toyle Generall or Speciall remainder by upon any ffor single generall or Speciall or come to them or any of them by dissent in ffor single ffor single Generall or Speciall or remainder upon any estate toyle as afforsed or by any other Lawfull conveyance or conveyances or manner whatsoever as if they and every of them had beene borne within this Province or wch of Brittish or Irish dissent as afforsed and alfor that they and every of them from hence forth shall and may be enabled to prosecute maintain & avow Justifward defend all manner of actions suits plaints or other demands whatsoeuer at liberally frankly ffreely Lawfully ffreely and Secundly as if all of them had beene Naturall borne within the Province of Maryland And the abovesaid Children of Anthony Lacount had beene ffor borne since their Conization by their said Father or wch of Brittish or Irish dissent as afforsed and as any
