or Irish descent may any wise lawfully do Any Law Proviso act or custome
of this Province or other thing whatsoever had made ordyned or done within
this Province to the contrary hereof in any wise Notwithstanding —

*An Act prohibiting all masters of shippes or vessells or
any other persons from Transporting or Convoying
away any person or persons out of this Province
without pass —*

Whereas severall persons freemen within this Province being indebted to the
Inhabitants thereof have been by masters of shippes and other vessells transported
and by others by land convoyed out of this Province and also severall servants
who had tyme by the custome of this Countrey condicōn for wages or Indenture to
serve have been transported and convoyed away as aforesaid to the great
manifest damage of their creditors and masters The Delgates of this present
General Assembly hauiding seriously considered the Inconveniences therby
accruing to the good people of this Province do pray that it may be enacted
And Bee it Enacted by the Right Honble the Lord Proprietary by and with the
advice and consent of this present General Assembly that from and after the Publication
of any person or persons whatsoever who shall intend to depart this Province
shall give notice of such his intended departing by setting up his name all the
Secretarys office for the full space of three whole moneths and that if within that
time no person shall underwrit the person respectively soe setting upp his
name as aforesaid it shall then be lawfull for his Lordshippes Gouernour Chancellor
or Secratary of this Province for this time being to signe a paſſe for any such
person to depart this Province for which paſſe the party shall pay as aſſide to
the person ſigning the ſame the ſumme of two ſhillings six pence Sterling —

And Bee it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid that any master of
Shippes or vessells or other person whatsoever that shall transport or Convoy out of
this Province by land or water any freeman being indebted by bill bond accompt
or otherwise unto any Inhabitant without ſuch paſſe vnder the hand of the
Gouernour Chancellor or Secratary of this Province for this time being as aforesaid
Shall be lyable to ſatisfie all ſuch debts Engagements & damages to the person
or persons to whom ſuch debts & damages respectively shall be due within
this Province vnto the ſame be otherwise ſatisfied in convenient time
or that in one moneth he cauſt or procure ſuch freeman to returne again into
the Province wherby he may be lyable to Justice here and dredge ſuch person
as aforesaid as ſhall transport or Convoy away of thiſ Province any Servant
or Servants being Servants here by condicōn for wages indenture or custome
of the Country Shall be lyable to pay and ſatisfie vnto thiſ master or owner of
ſuch Servant or Servants ſooe carried away all ſuch damages as he or they
shall
