Declaration of the Second of July one thousand six hundred forty five whereby
you did Impowder your Gouernour from time to time to grant land unto any
persons of French Dutch Spanish Swedish or other forreigne descent in the
Same and in as ample manner and vpon the same Ternures and Provisos
as he was thereby Impowred to grant land to any person or persons of
Brittish or Irish descent and during their said abode they haue beene
alwayes faithfull & obedient to your Lordshires Laws Yett for that your
Peticioners are not of Brittish or Irish descent they cannot take benefit
of the Lawes & Customes of this Province as other the said people of
this Province of Brittish or Irish descent may to their great losse —
prejudice & hindrance as also to the deterring of divers others of
the said forreigne Nationes aforesaid from coming into this Province and
by Conseqeuence foraslowing the poppling of this Province with vsfull
Artificers and handicraftsmen. May it therefore please your Lordship —
of your abundant goodness and wonted care of and over this Province that
it may be enacted & ordained by your Lordship. And Bee it Enacted and
ordained by the Right Honble the Lord Proprietary of this Province by and
with the advice of the upper & lower house of the present Generall Assembly
that your Lordshippe humble Petitioners Jacob Duhalloway Anthony —
Briscoe Peter Achilles they & every of them shall from henceforth be —
adjudged & reputed & taken as naturall borne people of this Province of Maryland
and also that they & every of them shall and may from henceforth by the
same Authority be enabled and adjudged to all intents and purp[er]spective
to demand challenge if they haue hold & enioy any lands Tenements Rents
and Hereditaments within this Province as Heir or heirs to any of their
Ancestors by reason of any descent in fide Simple & tayle Generall or —
Spediall or Remainder vpon any Estate Tayle as aforesaid or by any
other Lawfull Conveyance or conveyances or manner whatsoeuer as if
they and every of them had beene borne within this Province or were of
Brittish or Irish descent aforesaid and also that they and every of them from
henceforth may and shall be enabled to prosecute maintain & avow Justifie
and defend all manner of Actions suits plaints or other demands whatsoever
as Cōformally frankly freely Lawfully and Securly as if they and
every of them had beene Naturallie borne within this Province of Maryland
or were of Brittish or Irish descent and as any other person or persons
Naturallie born in this Province or of Brittish or Irish descent may —
any way Lawfully doe any Law Provisor Act or Custom of this Province
or any other thing whatsoever had made ordyned & done within this Province
to the Contrarie therof in any wise Notwithstanding
