Forasmuch as the Lawes of this Province have not as yett provided for the Satisfaction
of those persons that are Summoned twice yearly as Jurors out of the body of this Province
to attend Provinciall Courts the Deputyes & Delegates of this present Generall Assembly
doe humbly pray that itt may be Enacted And bee it Enacted by the Right Hon^eble the
Lord Proprietary by and with the advice and Consent of the upper and lower house
of this present Generall Assembly and the authority of the same That those persons
that are summond upon the grand Jury twice yearly out of the body of this
Province shall from henceforth be allowed for every Court that they shall soe attend as
Jurors two thousand five hundred pounds of Tobacco for their Expences and no more and
that every County Leavⁱng five hundred pounds of Tobacco Yearly to be paid to the Ordinary
Keoper of the Country houses att St. Maries that entertaine them this Acte to endure for three
yeardes or to the end of the next Generall Assembly which shall first happen

Whereas by an act of Assembly made att a Generall Assembly held att the City of St.
Maries the twelfth day of Februarie in the yeare of our Lord one thousand six hundred
Sixty and four Entituled an act of gratitud to his Excellency Charle^s Calvert Esq^r Capt^r
Generall of Maryland itt was Enacted that a former Act made att a Generall Assembly
held att the Said City of St. Maries the twenty seventh day of March one thousand six
hundred Sixty one Entituled an act for the rasing & providing a Support for his
Lordship the Lord and Proprietary of this Province during his naturall life And
likewise a Supply towards the defraying the publick charges of Government Itt was
Enacted that this Said Act & all and every the Articles Previsous matter and things therin
contained shold stand & be by that present Act ratified & confirmed to all intents &
purposes according to the true intent & meaning thereof not onely for and during the
life of the Right Hon^eble Cecilius Absolute Lord & Proprietary of this Province for
one yere after as aforesaid but alsoe for and during the naturall life of the Right
Hon^eble Charle^s Calvert Esq^r sonne & heire apparent of the said Cecilius Lord Proprietary
