

Shall doe Contrary directly or indirectly to this Act. Shall loose & forfeit to the party grieved trouble Damages And shall also forfeit the sume of Six thousand pounds of Tobacco or forty pound Starling for evry tyme he or they shall soe doe the contrary the one moiety to the Lord Proprietarij his Heires and Successors the other moiety to the party or parties that shall sue for the same by any plain Action Suits Bill or Information wherin no Espeynd Protection or wagon of Law shall be allowed Provided always that if any fees for any matter or thing hereafter to be done belonging to their severall offices or officers by the Right Honble the Lord Proprietarij or his Lieutenant & Gouverneur and Councill be allowed and adjudged, not in this Act mentioned permitted and allowed Then it shall be lawfull to have & Recieve such fees as the Lord Proprietary & Councill shall Judge and allow & no more under the penality aforesaid to be Recovered as aforesaid

An Act for easement of the Inhabitants of this Province  
in suits att Law for small Debts

Whereas the Inhabitants of this Province have been much grieved molested & troubled by being forced by Provinciall Courts to appear at the Provinciall Courts & fee Attorneys ther notwithstanding the debts for are very small & within the cognizance of the County Courts of this Province for the provision whereof for the future the bing off and delagation of this present Generall Assembly doe humbly pray that it may be enacted And Bee it Enacted by the Right Honble the Lord Proprietarij by and with the advice & consent of the Upper and Lower houses of this present Generall Assembly by the Authority of the same That from & after the publication hereof no action for a booke debt or for a plain Bill for or under the summe of fiftene hundred pounds of Tobacco & cash shall be commenced or prosecuted against any Inhabitant of this Province in the Provinciall Courts Except only upon appealals from the County Courts of this Province and attorneys of the Provinciall Courts & County Courts for their fees only who shall haue liberty to sue for the same in the Court where they are Attorneys And that no attorney of the Provinciall Court shall be allowed any privilege to debarre him from being sued in the County Court where he liues.

And bee it further enacted by & with the advice & consent aforesaid that if any person plaintiff shall commence or prosecute any suit or plaint in the Provinciall Court of this Province for or under the summe of fiftene hundred pounds of Tobacco & cash in manner and forme as aforesaid shall suffer a nonfeite & pay such costs to the Defendant as are usually granted by the Provinciall Courts of this Province.

And bee it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid That an accepce sworne to by this p[ro]t or a bill proved by his Evidence before any one Justice of the Provinciall Court or any two Justices of any County Court within this Province shall be sufficient Evidence to prove the said debts in any County Court within this Province Provided always that the party who shall swear or give Evidence as
