And Be it further Enacted by the advice consent & authority aforesaid That the aforesaid summs of Tobacco amounting in the whole to the summe of three thousand thirty seven thousand eight hundred forty four pounds of Tobacco be levied & assessed by the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Proprietary or his Lieutenant General or his Governour for the tyme being & Council according to an act of assembly passed this session of Assembly intituled An Act providing for the Security & defence of this Province & not otherwise by an equall assessment upon the persons & estates of the Inhabitants of this Province and paid to the severall persons to whom the same is due as aforesaid any Law Statute Customs or usage to the contrary hereof in any wise notwithstanding -

And Be it further Enacted by the advice consent & authority aforesaid That the Itinerant Charges of the Burgesses & Delegates of the Lower house of this present Gen^l Assembly as also the Itinerant Charges of such Delegates as shall come to lay the Levy shall be defrayed and paid by their respective Counties for which they are Delegates And the Charges & Expenses of all the said Delegates while they are at St. Marys about the Country or Business shall be borne & defrayed by the Publick And also that reasonable allowances be made to the members of the upper house of assembly that dwell remote from St. Marys for their victuall or Itinerant Charges in coming & going to lay & assess the next Levy And also their Charges while they are at St. Marys doing the same shall be paid and defrayed by the Publick any Law Statute Customs or usage to the contrary hereof in any wise notwithstanding -
