Act as aforesaid which said Rates and prices to be set assessed limited
and appointed by the Commissioners aforesaid and by the Magistrats of the City
aforesaid shall be by their severall respective Clerks fairly transcribed &
sett up at their severall respective County Courts and City aforesaid in some
Publick place or places there that any person or persons may see and perceive
the same for which Sumons and Tables of Prices every Ordinary Keeper
shall pay to such Clerks the sume of forty poundes of Tobacco And any Ordinary
Keeper or Inholder that shall after setting and assessing the Rates & prices
aforesaid directly or indirectly presume to take exact demand or receive for
the price and pay for any such liquors for which the Rates and prices shall be
sett and assessed as aforesaid ~~if he or she or any person or~~
person whatsoever above the Rates and prices to be set and assessed
as aforesaid shall for every such default forfeit and pay unto the Right
Hon^{ble} the Lord Proprietary the sume of five hundred poundes of Tobacco one
halfe thereof to his said Lordship and the other halfe to him or them that
shall inform and sue for the same and lose every such debt so unjustly
charged exacted and demanded the said forfeiture to be Recovered in any
Court of Record within this Province wherein noe Essoigns protection or
wager of Law to be allowed and every such ordinary keeper that shall
demand exact or receive above the sume of ten poundes of Gallon for small
Beere twenty poundes of Tobacco of Gallon for Strong Beere for a nights lodging
in above four poundes Tobacco for a peck of Indian Shells or Oat for a
horse twelve poundes of Tobacco for pasture for a horse of night six poundes of
Tobacco for hay or straw for a horse of night ten poundes of Tobacco shall
also pay and forfeit for every such default to the Lord Proprietary the
like sume of five hundred poundes of Tobacco one halfe thereof to his said
Lordship and the other halfe to him or them that shall inform and sue for the
same and lose his debt so unjustly charged as aforesaid the said forfeitures
to be Recovered in any Court of Record in this Province wherein noe Essoigns
protection or wager of Law to be allowed.

And to the intent that all persons Inhabitants Travellers and Strangers
as aforesaid may be Certain of sufficient accomodacion for themselves and
horses Beitt enacted by the Authority aforesaid that every Ordinary Keeper
or Inholder to be licensed as aforesaid shall within six months after
granting their respective Licenses be and are hereby obliged to provide &
maintain accomodacion of Oats hay and straw for Litter and Indian Com
together with Stable Rooms convenient and sufficient for twenty horse at
the least under the penalty of the forfeitures of paying the sume of ten thousand
poundes of Tobacco one halfe to the Lord Proprietary the other halfe to the
Informor or him or them that shall sue for the same to be Recovered by bill
plaint or Informacion in which noe Essoigns protection or wager of Law to be
allowed
