

allowed & provided always that no person or persons so licensed or to be licensed to
keep Ordinary as aforesaid shall during the time of such their keeping Ordinary
be Justices of the Peace or Commissioners in any County Court within this Province nor Mayor
Recorder nor alderman of the said City of St. Marys any thing in this Act to the contrary
notwithstanding.

And it is hereby enacted by the Authority aforesaid that any Ordinary keeper
keeping will Rule and order in his house and suffering Extraordinary drinking fighting
and Quarrelling in his house upon Complaint made thereof to the Justice of the County
Court of such Ordinary keepers misbehaviour of himselfe or keeping will rule in their
house the said Justice of the said County Court may and are hereby Authorized and
impowred to suppress such Ordinary and call in such Licenses.

And Godd it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid that any Ordinary
keeper disabled or suppressed as aforesaid or any other person that shall presume to
keep Ordinary without License first had and obtained as aforesaid shall for every
month he or they shall keep Ordinary as aforesaid forfeit and pay to the Lord
Proprietary ten thousand pounds of Tobacco one half thereof to his Lordship and
the other half to him or them that shall inform and sue for the same to be recovered
in any Court of Record in this Province by bill plaint or Information where in no Assign
protection or wager of Law to be allowed.

And lastly it is hereby enacted by the Authority aforesaid that the Justice
of the Provinciaall Court and the Commissioners of the Respective County Courts shall
give this Act in Charge to the severall grand Jurys as also the ^{severall} Commissioners of the
Respective County Courts and the Magistrates of the said City to their severall and
Respective Constables to enquire into the breach of this Act and into all disorders
committed in the said Ordinaries and present the same if any be to the said severall
Courts there to be examined and punished according to Law this Act to continue
for three yeares or to the end of the next Generall Assembly which shall first
happen.
