

And be it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid that the said Act Entituled an Act to prevent Unnecessary delays of executions made at a Generall Assembly held for this Province the fiftenth day of May one thousand six hundred seventy six and every part thereof be from henceforth wholly Repealed.

And lastly be it enacted by the Authority aforesaid that no officer or officers within this Province shall hereafter for any writ of Error Supersedias, or Scire facias, to have Judgment vpon Errors from the Provinciaall Court of this Province to any County Court or other inferior Court of this Province, receive or demand any more or other fee or fees than is hereafter mentioned (that is to say) for a writ of Error to the Secretary fifty pounds of Tobacco and to the Chancellor for the Seals thereof one hundred & twenty pounds of Tobacco for a Supersedias to the Secretary fifty pounds of Tobacco & to the Chancellor for the Seals thereof one hundred and twenty pounds of Tobacco for a Scire facias to the Secretary fifty pounds of Tobacco and to the Chancellor one hundred and twenty pounds of Tobacco for the Seals thereof and not more any act heretofore made or any Law usage or Customs to the contrary in any wise notwithstanding this Act to continue for three yeares or to the end of the next Generall Assembly which shall first happen.

An Act for limiting the County Clerks fees within this Province.

His Lordships the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Proprietary willing and desiring the ease and convenience of his good people in suites at Law did at the first Sessions of this Assembly by the advice and consent of the upper and lower houses of Assembly by an act entituled An Act for the ease of the Inhabitants of this Province in suites of Law for small debts Ordaine and enact that no debt under the sume of fiftens hundred pounds of Tobacco should be sued but in the County Court by means whereof multiplicity of suites and actions are moved and stirred in the said County Courts to the great profits of the Clerks thereof in their fees And whereas by another Act made at the same Assembly Entituled An Act for officers fees the Secretarys fees are settled which was never intended by the said Act to relate to any other matters then for fees relating to the Provinciaall Courts Secretarys office nor can the words in the same warrant any other construction, yett notwithstanding the said County Court Clerks by colour of the said Act (their fees having not as yett been otherwise settled) doe presume to take the same fees for such things as doe relate to their Respective offices as well limited to the Secretary to the great grievance of the many and poore suitors in the County Courts of which many complaints have been made to the Delegates of the Lower
