or adjudged to give power or libertie to any Sheriff of this Province to take  
demaned exact or Recived of any person or persons whatsoever for any arrest of  
any person whatsoever being in his custodij and hours less than four and twenty  
hours above the summe of thirtie five pounds of Tobacco under the penalty as in  
this Act therof is contained And for the better explanation of that Act for officers  
fees Had it enacted by the Authority aforesaid That for the future no officer or  
officer in the said Act mancomune shall by vertue therew<sup>r</sup> have any Execution  
upon the goods or body of any person whatsoever for any fees in the said Act  
mentione without first delivring a true & just account of the fees aforesaid  
under the hand or hands of such officer or officers to the person or persons from  
whom such fees are demanded And if any officer or officers shall charge any  
fees for any matter or thing wher<sup>r</sup> the said persons never had or Recived the same  
or shall doe any Matter or thing contrary directly or indirectly to the intent  
meaning of the said Act shall loose and forfeite as in the same Act is already provided
