An Act for payment and assessing the Publick Charges of this  
Province

Whereas there hath been eight hundred twenty five thousand Nyned hundred  
Seventy Nyned pounds of Tobacco expended layd out & disbursed by severall of the  
Inhabitants of this Province in the late Expedition against the Nanticoke Indians  
and other the necessary Charges of this Province which hath been Examined Stated  
and allowd by the upper and lower houses of this present Generall Assembly To the  
intent therefore That the same may be satisfied and payd to those persons to whom  
the same is due Be it enacted by the Right Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Lord Proprietary by and with  
the advice and consent of the upper and lower houses of this present Generall  
Assembly and the Vertuety of the same That the said eight hundred twenty five  
thousand Nyned hundred Seventy Nyned pounds of Tobacco be paid in manner &  
form as is hereafter Expressed by an Equall Assessment upon the persons &  
Estates of the Inhabitants of this Province And be payd to the severall persons  
to whom the same is due as aforesaid Any Law Statute Custome or vsage to the  
contrary thereof notwithstanding. That is to say To Captain William Horsley
