enacted by the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Prop^{ty} and with the advice &
assent of the upper and lower houses of this present Generall Assembly That
the said Edward Husband be and is hereby utterly disabled & made incapable
of ever practising as a Physician or Chirurgon within this Province And
if at any time or times hereafter he shall presume to practise As aforesaid
he shall for every such offence forfeit & pay the Just Summe of two
hundred pounds sterling one halfe thereof to the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord
Proprietary the other halfe to him or them that shall inform or sue for the
same And Be it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid That the said
Husband be bound personally to appear at the next Provinciaall Court
to answer the premises and in the meane time to be of good behaviour as
well toward his Lordship as to all the Inhabitants of this Province giving
good and sufficient Security for the same before some one or more of
his Lordships Council —

And whereas it hath appeared by sufficient proofs That the said
Edward Husband hath threatened menaced & cursed this present Assembly
Be it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid That for the
crimes of threatening menacing & cursing this Assembly as aforesaid
the said Husband be whipped on the bare back with twenty lashes
by the hand of the Common hangman —
