

or undelivered than the said matter and things by the said Publick Notary
or other officer appointed as aforesaid certified shall not be received in
evidence for valid against the Debtor.

Provided though the proofs and evidences are sufficient that the plaintiff
obtained Judgment for the said debt no Execution shall issue forth against the
Defond^t until the Original be given up or delivered up to the Defendant or
his Attorney or sufficient & legal release in case the Original be lost.

And Be it further Enacted that all and every the Attorney and Attorney,
who shall be employed in the prosecution of such suits shall put in Security to -
pay the Defendant all such costs and charges as shall be by the said Defendant
in that case demanded in case the plaintiff be cast in the suit.

Provided likewise that no Bill Bond Judgment Recoginized Statute
Merchant and of the Staples or other specialty what so ever though prov'd &
certified as aforesaid shall be good and pleadable or admitted in Evidence ag^t
any person or persons of this Province whom the Debtor and Creditor are
both dead and the debt or thing in demand or action above twelve years
standing.

An Act prohibiting all Masters of Ships or vessels or any other
persons from transporting or conveying away any person or persons
out of this Province without passsē.

Whereas severall persons freemen within this Province being indebted
to the Inhabitants thereof have been by masters of Ships and other vessels
transported and otherwise by land conveyed out of this Province and also severall
servants who had hym by the custome of the Country condition for wages or
Indenture to serve have been transported and conveyed away as aforesaid
to the great and manifest damage of their creditors and Masters, the Delegates
of this present Generall Assembly having therfore considered the Inconve-
niently thereby accruing to the good people of this Province do pray that
it may be enacted, And Be it enacted by the King and Queen most excellent
Majesties by and with the advice and consent of this present Generall assembly
and the authority of the same that from and after the Bulee an h[er]oof
any person or persons whatsoever who shall intend to depart this Province
