No. 10 An Act concerning proceedings at Law.

Whereas Sundry differences doth arise within this Province wherein there is no Rule or Law provided in this Province whereby to determine such differences for the avoiding the inconveniences as from thence may arise, Be it enacted by the King and Queen, most excellent Majesties by and with the advice and consent of this present Generall Assembly and the Authority of the same that when the Law of this Province is silent Justice shall be administered according to the Laws of England.

No. 11 An Act Prohibiting Commissioners Sheriffes Clerks and Deputy Clerks to plead as attornys in their respective County Courts.

Whereas many inconveniences have happened to divers persons within this Province by means of Commissioners Sheriffes Clerks pleading as attorneys in their respective Courts wherein they bear office, for prevention whereof for the future Be it therefore enacted by the King and Queen most Excellent Majesties by and with the advice and consent of this Generall Assembly and the Authority of the same that from and after the Publication of this Act no Commissioner Sheriff or Deputy Sheriff Clerk or Deputy Clerk of those Courts wherein they bear Office shall plead as attorney for or in behalf of any person or persons at that time residing or being within this Province upon the penalty of three thousand pounds of Tobacco the one half thereof to their said Majesties for the support of Government the other moiety to the Informer or him or them that shall sue for the same to be recovered in any Court or Courts of Record within this Province by Bill plaint or Information wherein no Esayne Protection or wager of Law to be allowed.

No. 12 An Act prohibiting trade with the Indians for any flesh dead or alive except deer and wild fowl.

Whereas sundry Complaints have been made by several Inhabitants of this Province alldading that the Indians under pretence of killing wild hogs do hunt and driv away their tame hogs and cattle and do moreover sell and trade with the Inhabitants of this Province and likewise with strangers and strangers for Beefs & Porkes, Be it enacted by the King &
