

Commissioners of the County Courts and the said Mayor Aldermen
of the said City be and are hereby further Impowered & Authorized at their
severall County Courts and Mayor Courts in the month of January and
in the month of August halfe yearly in every year during the continuance
of this Act having summoned every respective Ordinary Keeper within their
respective County and City there and there to appear before them there and
there to set and affix the Rates and prices of all liquors whatsoever (in this
Act not heretofore mentioned) by them the said Ordinary Keepers vouched
or to be vouched for the year ensuing and so for every year during the
continuance of this Act which rates and prices so to be set affixed limited
and appointed by the Commissioners aforesaid and by the Magistrates of the
City aforesaid shall be by their severall and respective Clerks fairly
transcribed and set up at their severall and respective County Courts and
City aforesaid in some publick place or places there that any person or persons
may peruse the same for which summes and table of prices every Ordinary
Keeper shall pay to such Clerk the summe of forty pounds of Tobacco and any
Ordinary Keeper or Inholder that shall after the setting and affixing the
Rates and prices aforesaid directly or indirectly take exact and demand or
Proceede for the price and pay for any such liquors for which the Rates &
prices shall be set and affixed as aforesaid of any person or persons
whatsoever above the rates and prices so affixed as aforesaid shall for every
such offence forfeit and pay the summe of five hundred pounds of Tobacco
one halfe thereof to their Majesties and the other halfe to him or them
that shall inform and sue for the same, and lose every such debt so
unjustly charged exacted and demanded the said forfeiture to be recovered
in any Court of Record within this Province wherein no Stay or Protection
or wager of Law to be allowed and every such Ordinary Keeper that
shall demand exact or Proceede above the summe of ten pounds of
Tobacco of Gallon for small Beer twenty pounds of Gallon for strong Beer
for a nights lodging in a Bedd four pounds of Tobacco for a peck of Indian
shoe Corn or Oats for an horse twelve pounds of Tobacco for
pasturage for an horse of night six pounds of Tobacco for hay or
straw for an horse of night ten pounds of Tobacco shall also pay
and forfeit for every such offence the summe of five hundred pound
of Tobacco one halfe thereof to their said Majesties and the other
