said severall debts it shall and may be lawfull for any two of their Majesty
Justices of the respective Counties within this Province upon due proove
made before them two of the Justices of the said Debt and of the said
Sheriffs sworn as aforesaid and the parties Debtors refusing to make
that full satisfaction to their Creditors for their said Debts at the said
Creditors Request to award him Execution with Cost against the body
goods or Chattels of such Debtor to be executed by the severall Sheriffs
for the satisfaction of the said Creditors Just Debt in as full and ample
manner as if the said Debts had been paid legally recovered by due
Course of Law Provided that the said Justices doe call for them both
parties and witnesses for due proove of the debt of the said Debt &
of the said Sheriffs sworn as aforesaid and as well in that as in all
other Civil causes in their Majesty's Courts within this Province the party
cast shall satisfy the cost and Court charges and that no Sheriffe within
this Province shall seize any persons Inhabiting within this Province
their Tobacco houses or their Tobacco hanging unstript or unpaet but
only Tobacco packt in casks for Levys nor mark any Merchants
or others kind of Tobacco received marked or nailed as aforesaid and
Remaining in the houses of any person within this Province undisposed
off by the Merchant or other persons for whom the same was received
for any cause whatsoever but only for Levys and any Sheriffe for
seizing and marking any Tobacco houses or seizing any kind of tob:
containing more than what is Justly due to the Publick for Levys shall
pay for every such default the sum of two Thousand pounds of tob:
and halfe to their Majesty for the support of Government the other
halfe to the party grieved to be recovered by action at law bill plaint
or Information in any Court within this Province in which no Offence
Protection or wager of Law to be allowed

An Act for marking high ways and making the heads of
Rivers Creeks & Branches or Swamps passable for horse & foot
Whereas it is thought convenient and very much for the benefit of
the Inhabitants of this Province that ways and paths be marked and
the heads of Rivers Creeks and Branches be made passable See it therefore
