cast shall satisfy the cost and Court charges and that no Sheriff within
this Province shall Sizur any person Inhabiting within this Province
their Tobacco houses or their Tobacco hanging unstriped or unpatched But

or others kinds of Tobacco received marked or nailed as aforesaid and
Remaining in the houses of any person within this Province undisposed
of by the Merchant or other persons for whom the same was received

Seizing and marking any Tobacco houses or seizing any kind of tob.
