

other person as in his discretion he shall think fit which said Administrat^r or
appointed shall give security as all Adm^rs do and shall sue and Imp^load the
former Adm^r before the Judge aforesaid for an account of the estate of the
Intestate and in case it shall appear to the Judge aforesaid that the former Adm^r
hath wasted or Imbezilled the estate of the Intestate then the Judge shall
assign the bond entered into by the former Adm^r and his security unto the
latter Adm^r to be holden against them for such wasting or Imbezilling
2: That the Judge upon account given by the first Adm^r as aforesaid shall make
Division of the clear estate of the deceased after debts paid and funeral
Expenses defrayed that is to say shall allow to the widow or Heir of the
said Intestate if any such be one full third part thereof and the other two
thirds shall be equally divided among the Children of the said deceased (if
any such be) and if no such be then between the next of blood of the said
Intestate and after such Division made shall transmit the account thereof
to the Justices of the severall and Respective County Courts where the said
Estate shall be and remain who are by this Act appointed Authorized and
Enjoyned to putt the persons lands goods and Chattels of the Orphans into the
hands of such persons as they shall think fit taking bond with two sufficient
Sureties in the name of the Orphans themselves for security and delivery of
the said Estate to the said Orphans or their Guardians when they come
Lawfully called according to the Rules and directions hereafter by this
Act prescribed Established and Ordained and not otherwise which Rules
shall be Rules not only for the Justices of the County Courts to proceed by in
taking the accounts of Guardians or trustees for Orphans but also for the
Judge for probat of wills and granting Adm^racons in taking the account of
Adm^rs and Bond Executors to the benefit of others nor shall the Judge make
any other allowances to any Adm^r or Adm^r upon his or their account but
for Debts bona fide owing from the deceased and really paid or secured
to be paid by the severall and Respective Adm^rs

Imp^r: No Negro or other slave shall be sold or disposed off by any Adm^r for
payment of debts or otherwise Reserved for the Adm^r now up in
satisfaction for any debts due to the said Adm^r nor any execution forced
upon any Negro or other slave so long as there shall be other goods of
the Deceased sufficient to satisfy the Just debts of the deceased but
