An Act for settling of Navall Officers fees within this
Province

96. 36. Whereas for some years past masters of shippes and other vessells trading
into this Province have used to pay at the tyme of the clearing of such
shippes or vessell for each respective clearing the sum of two pound, one
shilling) and four pence under protest of Secretaries fees besides other
fees to severall the Inferiour Officers for writing their entries, receipts
and clearings, which said Secretaries and other Officers fees as aforesaid
were not only unreasonable but also Illegal and unjust being exacted
and extorted from the aforesaid Masters of shippes or other vessells as
aforesaid without any pretence or colour of Law or Justice what-
= soever but for that It doth appear to this present Generall Assembly
that there is a necessity of settling fees for maintaining such Officer
Officers as shall be from tyme to tyme appointed for entering and clearing
such shippes or vessells as aforesaid, Be it therefore enacted by the
King and Queens most Excellent Majesties by and with the advice and
consent of this present Generall Assembly and the Authority of the same
that from and after the Publication hereof every master of a shippes
or vessell trading into this Province upon clearing his said shippes or vessell
as aforesaid shall allow and pay unto their Majesties Governour for the
tyme being the sum of forty shillings sterling and no more for such his
entering and clearing and granting permits as aforesaid their said
