- 3<sup>rd</sup> And for the settling the horse forces that a Captain of horse in each  
Respective County for making up of his troop Elect and Enlist his number  
of men out of the Inhabitants of the said County according to such Instruction  
as he shall from time to time receive from the Governor of this Province  
for the time being Provided always that such troopers shall keep their  
own horses and that no person shall be a trooper without he be owner  
of a good serviceable horse which shall pass muster, and that such troopers  
in consideration of their great pay hereafter to be allowed to board and  
obliged to find themselves with good able and sufficient garniture for  
their horses and likewise to find themselves with swords carbines pistol,  
Holsters and Ammunition, and if any trooper shall neglect or refuse upon  
notice given to them in manner as aforesaid to the foot to appear at  
musters at the time and place appointed as aforesaid by each Respective  
Captain of horse accounted and equipped as aforesaid shall forfeit and  
pay the sum of one hundred pounds of Tobacco to be levied as aforesaid  
forthough of the troops for trumpet and drums and other necessaries as  
the Commander shall think fit and that all such troopers for and in considera-  
tion aforesaid at all such times as they are out a ranging shall find  
their own provisions But when in Actual Service to be found Pro-  
visions at the Charge of this Province to be paid by the Publick and if it  
shall happen that any troopers horse be killed in the service then the  
said trooper to be paid for the said horse by the Publick and not otherwise  
4<sup>th</sup> That all persons in holy orders Delegates Magistrates and Constables shall  
in their proper persons be exempted from being compelled to muster &  
train either in horse or foot during such time as they officiate or  
such Officer as aforesaid, Provided that this clause shall not extend to such  
persons as already have or shall hereafter accept of Commissions for military  
Service from the Governor of this Province for the time being so as to  
discharge such persons from their Respective charges mentioned in such their  
overall and Respective Commissions, neither shall this clause or any part thereof  
be construed or taken to exempt any Delegates Magistrates or Constables as  
aforesaid to stand into the field to muster or training either to horse or
