And to the intent that the Inhabitants of this Province may not be abridged  
by having their goods and provissons prest by looff and lode follows who  
many times abuse their Comissions and the people, So it Enacted by the  
Authority aforesaid that from henceforth the Commissioners of each  
Respective County shall yearly and every Year (wch: t) between the  
twentie Neynth day of September and the twentie fiftieth day of December  
nominate and appoint honest and substantiallmen of their Countys for  
every hundred to be prest masters for one year ensuing and if any  
one dyd or depart the County or Colam: or sick within that tyme that  
then the next Justice of peace to nominate and appoint another in his stead  
that if occasion required they and no other shall imprest virtually or other  
things given them in Charge to be prested by warrant from his Excellency  
the Governor in chife for that tyme being, and if any other but prest  
masters so appointed shall presume upon pretence of any power as a  
prest master to lize take prest or carry away any goods or commodity  
of any the Inhabitants of this Province shall pay to the person grieved  
treble the value of the goods or commodity so aforesaid unrightly  
prested, Provided that no prest master or any person or persons whiche-  
over shall presume at any time to lize prest or carry away from  
any Inhabitant Resident in this Province any arms or Ammunition of  
any kind whatsoever upon any duty or service or upon any account  
whatsoever under the penality aforesaid any law statute or usage to  
contrarie hereof in any wise notwithstanding ~
