All which grain or grains, Berke beefe, Bacon as aforesaid shall be (to be found sweet & merchantable, and for the better carriage and transportation of Berke and beefe which upon that account may be otherwise subject to some greater Inconvenience) than other the Commodities aforesaid. Be it enacted that Berke and beefe shall be paid and received in good and sufficient Cash and Barrells (containing) thirty two Gallons neere of which thirty six pounds for the tare, and be it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid that it shall be lawfull to and for all manner of persons whatsoever (inhabiting) or traders into this Province to buy export or carry away any quantity or quantities of Berke Berke beefe or Bacon as aforesaid into any Dominion or Country out of this Province without any manner of restraint Prohibition or any other Imposition other than is already by the Laws of this Province imposed or allowed off any Law usage or Ordinance to the contrary in any wise notwithstanding. Provided and be it enacted by the Authority aforesaid that this Act nor anything therein contained shall not be construed deemed or taken to have any retrospect looking back or Relation to any Tobacco or money debt or debts made or contracted before the end of this present session of Assembly any thing in this Act to the contrary notwithstanding. Provided And be it enacted by the Authority aforesaid that if any Debt or Debts shall or may be payable or due from or to any person or persons Debtor or Creditor (living) or trading) into this Province under thirty three shillings & four pence or four hundred pounds of Tobacco that then and in such case shall be tendered and paid in any one particular Commodity or kind of Commodity Provision that is made current and rated as aforesaid, and not in divers the said particular kind or Commodity to be at the Election of the payer or buyer. This Act to endure for three years or to the end of the next Generall Assembly which shall first happen.
