

and consent of this present y^enerall Assembly and the Authority of the same that the Clerk of the Assembly for the tyme being transcribe the said Journall within two monthes after the Dissolution or Prorogation of the said Assembly and Deliver the same into the secretaries Office upon the penalty of five hundred pounds of Tobacco to our Sovereign Lord and Lady the King and Queen for the support of this Government and the Loss of his salary for his service in the Assembly the said fyne and forfeiture to be levied upon the said Clerk by the appointment of the Governour of this Province for the tyme being upon certificate from the secretary of this Province for the tyme being that the said Journall as aforesaid is not by the Clerk of the Assembly delivered into the secretaries Office aforesaid And it is hereby further enacted by the Authority aforesaid that the secretary of this Province for the tyme being shall be enjoyned to examine the secretaries Office touching the purport of this Act and make certificate to the Governour for the tyme being that thereby the fyne and forfeiture aforesaid may the more duly be paid —

An Act Concerning Indians

To the end that no breach of Peace may happen betwixt the neighbouring Indians & the Inhabitants of this Province, Be it enacted by the King and Queens most Excellent Majesties by and with the advice & consent of this present y^enerall Assembly and the Authority of the same that any one whosoever shall take entree, surprize, transport or cause to be transported or sell and dispose of any friend Indian or Indians whatsoever or endeavour or attempt so to do without License from the Governour for the tyme being, and all accessories therunto shall be fined & Imprisoned at the discretion of the Governour and Council for the tyme being, howbeit any one Informing or causing such offenders to be apprehended shall have satisfaction for his pains and diligences therein as the Governour and Council shall thinke fitt —
