or Confession of the party to be recovered in any Court in this Province by
Action of Debt Bill plaint or Information whereon no Effoynd wage or pro-
tection of law to be allowed, And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid
by and with the advice and consent aforesaid that if the goods so traded or
bartered as aforesaid shall exceed the sum of one Thousand pounds of Tobacco
that then the party or parties whose goods shall be Embroyled or bartered away
as aforesaid shall have the action at law for his Damages sustained against
the person or persons so offending dealing and bartering for the same any
thing in this Act to the contrary hereof in any wise notwithstanding, And in
case such person or persons so offending shall not be able to satisfy the
same then such person or persons shall be bound over by some one Justice
of the peace and put in security either to appear at the Provincial or
County Court where upon Conviction by Confession or sufficient witness
the Offender shall be punished by whipping on the bare back with thirty
strikes And for the Just ascertaining and limiting of servants tyms of
servitude Be it Enacted by and with the advice and consent of Authority
aforesaid that whosoever shall transport any servant into this Province without
Indenture, such servant being above the age of two and twenty years shall
shall be obliged to serve the full space and term of five years if between
Eighteen and two and twenty without Indenture, six years if between fifteen
and Eighteen without Indenture, seven years if under fifteen and
without Indenture shall serve till he or they arrive at the full age of two
& twenty years, And be it further Enacted by the advice consent and Authority
aforesaid that all servants transported out of Virginia into this Province
shall complete their tym of servitude here which they ought to have
served in Virginia and no more And be it further Enacted that every
M^r or Dame assigned or trusted whatsoever owning or keeping any
such servant as aforesaid whether by virtue of transportation purchase
or otherwise shall within six months after the receiving of such
servant into their custody within this Province (except he she or they
claim but five years service of such servant) bring the said servants
into the respective County Courts where they do inhabit and deliver
