

day) of April and the tenth day of October in any year in the Province or of any of the County Courts within this Province for any cause whatsoever or thing wherfor provided such person or persons against whom any such judgment is obtained shall immediately after obtaining such judgment together with two other parties such as the Justices shall approve off come before one Justice or more of the Provincial Court or two Justices or more of the respective County Courts where such judgment is obtained and confess judgment to the party that obtained the judgment as is aforesaid for his debt and cost of suit adjudged with a waffal execution till the tenth day of October then next following and therewith procure certificate under the hand of the said Justice or Justices before whom the said judgment shall be confessed and such certificate shall be a sufficient supersedes to the Sheriff to forbear serving execution upon the body or goods of the person so obtaining such certificate and if the party be taken in execution before such certificate be produced that then such certificate being obtained afterward as aforesaid shall be a sufficient supersedes to the Sheriff for the release of such person out of prison upon that execution the party paying or giving security to such Sheriff for his due fees for that imprisonment and the Justice or Justices before whom such judgment shall be confessed as aforesaid shall return the judgment so confessed unto the Clerk of that respective Court where the first judgment was obtained to be entered upon Record for which entry the Clerk shall receive as aforesaid few pounds of Tobacco and no more any law custom or usage to the contrary in any wise notwithstanding

An Act for killing of wolves

Bee it enacted by the King and Queens most Excellent Majesties by and with the advice and consent of this present Generall Assembly and the Authority of the same that every person that shall bring the head of a Wolfe to any of the Commissioners or Justices of the peace in any County in this Province shall be allowed two hundred pounds of Tobacco from the County where the Wolfe shall be killed and that such Commissioner or Justice of the Peace to whom the Wolfe shall be brought shall cut out or cause to be cut out the Tongue
