AN Act Ascertainning the expences of the Commissioners of the
Provinciall County Courts

Be it enacted by the King and Queens most Excellent Majesty by &
with the advice and consent of this present Generall Assembly and the
Authority of the same that from and after the end of this present Session of
Assembly that the Commissioners of the severall and Respective County Courts
of this Province shall not have further power and Authority to Levy upon
the Inhabitants of their severall and Respective Countys for defraying
their Charges & expences during the time of holding their said County
Courts above the sum of one hundred and Twenty pounds of Tobacco and
no more for every Commission that appears and sits there during
the time of their said Courts or about the publick affairs of the said County
And be it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid that every Justice of
the Provinciall Court that hath no place of profit within the Province shall
be allowed out of the Publick Levy one hundred and Eighty pounds of Tobacco
per day and no more for every day he shall be during the said Courts
As also hee shall be allowed any lawfull Statute or Customs to the
Contrary in any wise notwithstanding This Act to endure for three years
or to the end of the next Generall Assembly which shall first happen This
Act is to extend to all Countys in this Province except sumpter County who
is hereby allowed the sum of Eight Thousand pounds of Tobacco per year
it being at the speciall Request of the Representatives of the said County

AN Act for the preservation of the severall harbours
within this Province

Whereas Divers persons as well the Inhabitants of this Province as
foraigners hitherto trading in Shippes of great burthen as also in other
small vessells have notwithstanding laws formerly enacted against the
unloading of Ballast in the Creeks or harbours where they usually trade
within this Province in contempt of the said laws or by pleading ignorance
(them notwithstanding the Secretaries of this Province)
